

# The Real Christian Life #7 1 John 3:4-10 **THE REAL TEST**

These verses deal with the Christian's incompatibility with sin. John is pretty clear—born again persons do not habitually sin, nor seek to be unrighteous. So, righteousness should be considered a true test of whether or not one is truly a child of God. In this passage, John gives 4 reasons why a true Christian cannot habitually practice sin. Because a true Christian:
