### Mission Update

**Water for Good:** We work with employees in seven countries. We coordinate construction and drilling projects in five countries and work with even more regional and local officials. We ship pumps, pipes, and tools to remote locations. We choose to go to hard-to-reach places because we know the need is so great. Because we intentionally work in difficult-to-reach places, we are not surprised when we run into challenges. Last year, we had a major hang-up importing needed supplies into the Central African Republic. It set back construction on many projects. It was an often-featured prayer request in 2024, but praise be to God, we are starting to receive the needed supplies. Romans 5:3-5 reminds us that our trials can lead to growth if we patiently endure. Things often don't work out the way we planned. The question isn't whether we will face challenges, but what we will do when we face them.
