Missionary Update

Elvis & Sulee Tangko serving with Wycliffe Bible Translators in Cameroon:

Please continue to pray for Cameroon. We just had presidential elections 2 weeks ago and we're still awaiting results. We pray for peace in this country and peace in our hearts during these times. We are working on our long-term project, a full-length retelling of the story of Ruth in an African perspective. We're testing out gear, writing the script, writing a project proposal, and growing in our knowledge of God's Word. We just finished the 1st quarter at the Greenhouse Learning Center. And as the director, I'm already starting to plan for next year. We have 2 teaching gaps, as one teacher goes on furlough and one teacher is leaving the field permanently. If you know a teacher interested in serving overseas, please let me know - I'd love to talk to them. One of the teaching positions is 3rd & 4th grade - which will be Avi's class.
